Draft UERC (Tariff and Other Terms for Supply of Electricity from Non-conventional and Renewable Energy Sources) Regulations, 2009

In exercise of its powers conferred under Section 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003, the Commission had issued the Draft UERC (Tariff and Other Terms for Supply of Electricity from Non-conventional and Renewable Energy Sources) Regulations, 2009. The Commission proposes to make the following amendments in the draft Regulations issued by it.

"The following provisos are proposed to be inserted in Regulation 44(3) after the first proviso:

"Provided that where the generator proposes to supply electricity outside the State and directly to any High Tension (HT) consumer within the State shall have to bear the entire transmission/wheeling charges for the dedicated lines of the licensees used only for evacuation of such power.

Provided further that where more than one generator proposes to supply electricity outside the State and directly to any High Tension (HT) consumer within the State shall have to bear the entire transmission/wheeling charges for the dedicated lines of the licensees used only for evacuation of power from such generators in proportion to their installed capacity. "
