NOTIFICATION

No. F-9(10)RG/UERC/2012/1293--In exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section (1)(g) of Section 86 read with sub-section (2)(zg) & (2) (zp) of section 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003, and all other powers enabling it in this behalf and after previous publication, the Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following amendments in the Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission (Fees and Fines) Regulations, 2002 (Principal Regulations), namely :

1. Short title and commencement :

- (1) These Regulations may be called the Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission (Fees and Fines) (First Amendment) Regulations, 2012.
- (2) These shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. Amendment of Schedule of Principal Regulation :

Part A--The Schedule referred to in Regulation 3(1), 4(2), 4(5) and Regulation 7 of the Principal Regulation and forming part of the Principal Regulation shall be replaced by the Schedule as appended to these Regulations.
