No. F-9(2)(I)/RG/UERC/2014/1685. In exercise of powers conferred under section 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003, and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, and after previous publication, the Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following regulations to amend the Uttaranchal Regulatory Commission (Appointment of Consultants) Regulations 2004 (Principal Regulations), namely:

1. Short Title, Commencement and Interpretation

- (1) These Regulations may be called the Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission (Appointment of Consultants) (First Amendment) Regulations, 2014.
- (2) These Regulations shall extend to the whole of the State of Uttarakhand.
- (3) These shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. After sub-regulation (2) of Regulation 15 of the Principal Regulations the following shall be added at the end:

- (3) The full time individual Consultants working in the Commission shall be entitled to a total of 11 Casual Leaves during the Contract Period of 11 months that can be accumulated up to the period of Agreement.
- (4) The full time individual Consultants working in the Commission shall also be entitled to a total of 2 days Earned Leaves for every 1 month of completed service.
- (5) The individual Consultants would be required to get the approval of the Reporting Officer before going on casual leave.
- (6) The Consultants before going on Earned Leaves would be required to seek prior written approval of the Commission at least 3 weeks in advance of going on leave.
- (7) No leaves will allowed to be carried forward after expiry of the Contract Period and no additional remuneration shall be paid if leaves remain due.
- (8) The administration department of the Commission shall maintain the leave records of the individual consultants and verify the same in their monthly bills.
- (9) The Commission shall have the power to amend any of the conditions of leave.
