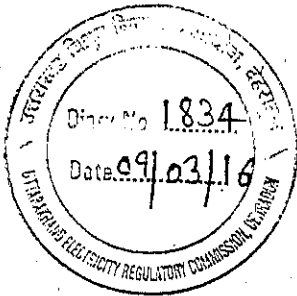

Reply of SLDC on Stakeholder Comments- V K Garg

Stakeholder Comments


SLDC MYT 16-17-18-19, it reveals increase from 7.45 crore approved for FY 2015-16 revised to 9.59 crores. For FY 2016-17 there is a 28% increase in one year i.e. from FY 2015-16 to FY 2016-17. The proposal for 18-19 when compared to 16-17 shows an increase of 123% in SLDC expenses. This magnitude of increase is something uncalled for, unless there are major capital replacements, which I do not think are called for so early.

It may be verified as to what are the major capital expenditure, and what are the major capital expenditure and what are the elements of necessity for the same.

SLDC's Response

As the standards of grid practices have become more stringent, Petitioner has to make more sturdy efforts for proper grid monitoring and data acquisition. In order to have a robust monitoring and communication backbone, Petitioner has structured its capital expenditure and detail breakup of capital expenditure and other expenses are provided in the MYT and Business Plan petitions, which are under review. These includes Supply and laying of approx. 600Km of OPGW along with Fibre Optical Terminal Equipment (FOTE) and RTU installation at various location across Uttarakhand. Thus it is humbly requested to the Hon'ble Commission to allow same to Petitioner.
